The Testing Center offers a variety of testing services to students and the public. These services include:

- Exams required for admission to NTC programs (Accuplacer, Windows/Windows Concepts, Differential Aptitude Test)
- Exams required for acceptance into apprenticeship programs (Mechanical, Spatial, Reading, Math)
- Microsoft Office Specialist certification exams
- VUE certification exams
- GED/HSED exams
- CLEP exams
- Proctored exams by appointment

ADMISSIONS TESTING

All students enrolling at NTC are required to take the Accuplacer test for admissions unless otherwise indicated.

ACCUPLACER

Description: The Accuplacer test measures a student's academic skill level in the areas of arithmetic, algebra, reading comprehension and sentence skills. Length: Approximately 30 minutes for each of the four exam areas (2 hrs. total)

WINDOWS AND WINDOWS CONCEPTS

These tests are needed for admission to Accounting, CIS, Administrative Assistant and other programs and are taken at the time the individual is scheduled to take the Accuplacer.

DIFFERENTIAL APTITUDE TEST (DAT)

This test measures a student's aptitude in mechanical reasoning and spatial relations. The charge for the DAT is \$15 but is waived if taken in conjunction with the Accuplacer.
