The Testing Center offers a variety of testing services to students and the public. These services include:

- Exams required for admission to NTC programs (Accuplacer, Windows/Windows Concepts, Differential Aptitude Test)
- Exams required for acceptance into apprenticeship programs (Mechanical, Spatial, Reading, Math)
- Microsoft Office Specialist certification exams
- VUE certification exams
- GED/HSED exams
- CLEP exams
- Proctored exams by appointment

GED/HSED TESTING

This battery of tests is offered to eligible individuals who have not completed high school and who wish to obtain a certificate of General Education Development (GED) or High School Equivalency Diploma (HSED). The GED consists of a battery of five tests: writing skills, social studies, science, reading and math. The most common way to receive an HSED is to take the five GED tests and complete additional requirements in health, civics and employability skills.

Eligibility: Individuals who are over 18 ½ years of age or whose high school class has graduated are eligible if they have not earned GED scores sufficient to qualify for a high school equivalency diploma. Other requirements and/or exceptions may apply.

Cost: \$75.00 for GED battery, and \$15 fee for credential/diploma. The cost to retest is \$15 per exam. The tests are scheduled through the NTC Testing Centers at Wausau and outlying campuses. The individual must complete an application/registration session and pay their fee before scheduling to take these tests.
