## INTRODUCTION

This plan has been prepared and adopted in accordance with the provisions of Wisconsin Statute 38.10(2)(c).

A public meeting of the Northcentral Technical College District Board Appointment Committee convened on April 9, 2007, to discuss the previously existing plan of representation revised and adopted March 22, 2006. The members of the Board Appointment Committee reviewed population statistics to validate the plan or make changes if appropriate.

The plan for representation is described below.

## PLAN FOR REPRESENTATION

### Geographic and Population Base Representation

The Northcentral Technical College District will be apportioned into three Board Appointment Regions for purposes of achieving both geographic and population representation.

The three Board Appointment Regions are coterminous with the boundaries of the "regionalized service delivery plan" of Northcentral Technical College:

#### A. West Board Appointment Region Description

The district portions of Price, Taylor, and Clark counties; and the following municipalities in southwestern Marathon County: (C) Abbotsford; Bern; Brighton; Cleveland; (C) Colby; Day; Eau Pleine; (V) Fenwood; Frankfort; Holton, Hull; Johnson; McMillan; Spencer; (V) Spencer; (V) Stratford; (V) Unity; Wien.

#### B. East Board Appointment Region Description

The district portions of Langlade, Shawano, Menominee, Portage, and Waupaca Counties; and the following municipalities in Southeastern Marathon County: Bevent; Elderon; (V) Elderon; Franzen; (V) Hatley; Norrie; Plover; Reid; Ringle.

#### C. Central Board Appointment Region Description

The district portion of Lincoln County plus municipalities in Marathon County except the following located in southwest and southeast Marathon County: (C) Abbotsford; Bern; Bevent; Brighton; Cleveland; (C) Colby; Day; Eau Pleine; Elderon; (V) Elderon; (V) Fenwood; Frankfort; Franzen; (V) Hatley; Holton; Hull; Johnson; McMillan; Norrie; Plover; Reid; Ringle; Spencer, (V) Spencer; (V) Stratford; (V) Unity; Wien.

#### D. Populations in Board Appointment Regions

The population of the Northcentral Technical College District based upon the 2006 Wisconsin Department of Administration (WI DOA) is 230,916. Estimates indicate that the gender population is evenly distributed. The gender population for the NTC District is 49.68% Female and 50.32% Male.

The minority population rate based on the 2000 Census is 7%. This data is supplied voluntarily by citizens and may not be a reflection of the total minority population for the area.

## E. Number of Trustees From Each Region

The geographic Board Appointment Regions will be represented by eight (8) of the nine members of the District Board of Trustees. The ninth trustee, who will be that individual appointed as the designated school district administrator member of the District Board of Trustees, will be appointed without regard to geographic representation or for population distribution.

The number of District Board of Trustees members to be appointed in each Board Appointment Region is based upon Analysis of the populations of the regions:

### Other Representation Criteria of the Board of Trustees

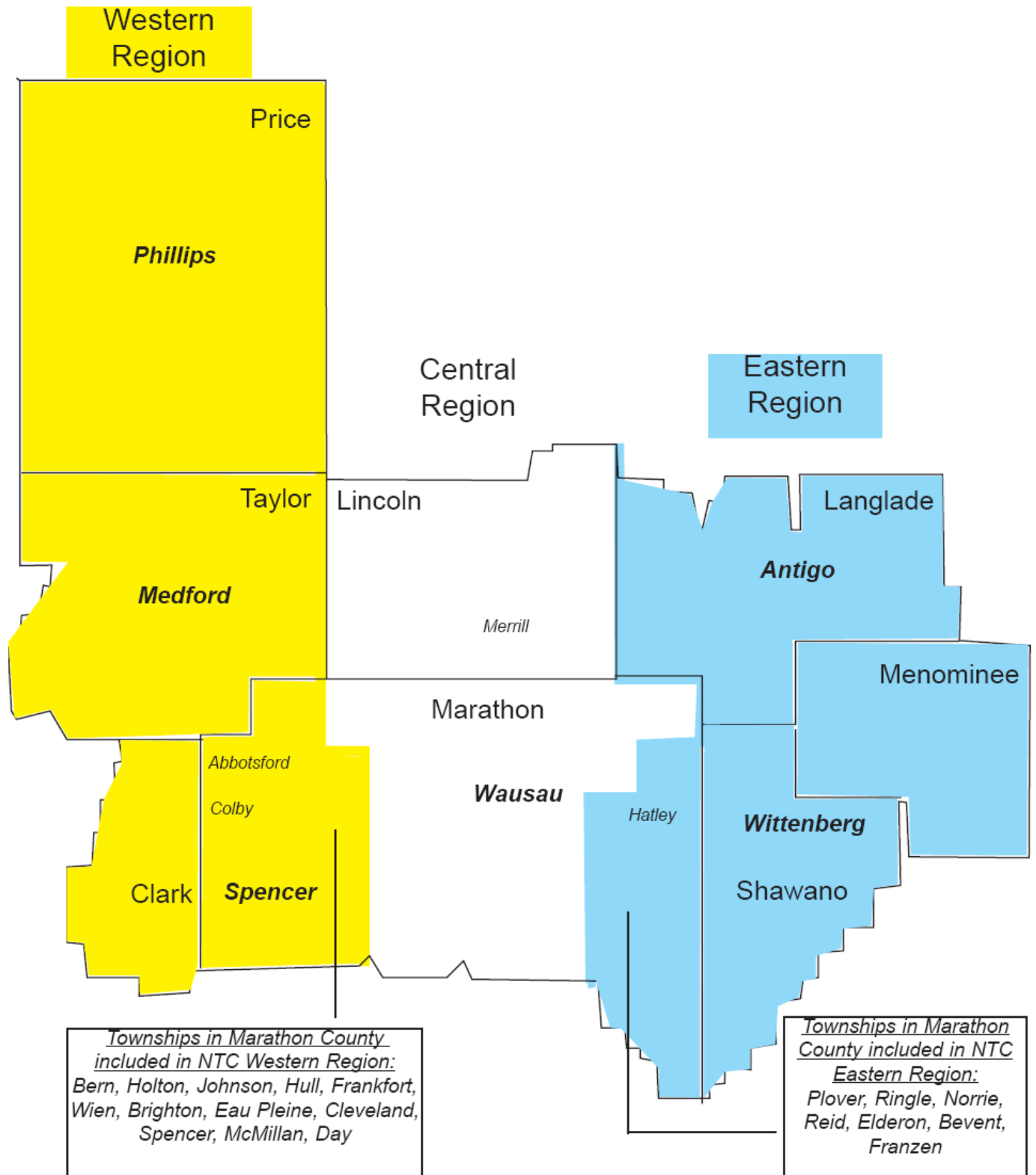
In addition to geographic and population representation, the following criteria must be met in the selection of the members for the Board of Trustees:

1. Criteria established, and changed from time to time, by statute or administrative codes of the State of Wisconsin.
2. A minimum of three (3) members of either sex must be appointed.
3. A minimum of one (1) minority member must be appointed.
